**REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP) FOR CONSTITUTION OF BIODIVERSITY MANAGEMENT COMMITTEES (BMCs)**

Request for Proposal (RFP) in sealed cover is hereby invited district-wise till 4.00 PM on 15/12/2018 on behalf of the Tripura Biodiversity Board (TBB), Agartala from the interested & eligible agencies/ NGOs/ Teams having required qualification for constitution of Biodiversity Management Committees (BMCs) to effectively implement the Biological Diversity Act.

**2. Background**

Tripura Biodiversity Board (TBB) has been constituted in the State vide No.F.8(31)/A/For-WL/98/Part-II/7309-40 dated 16<sup>th</sup> June, 2008 in pursuance of the Biodiversity Act, 2002 of Government of India with the following mandate:.

- a) To advise the State Government, subject to any guidelines issued by the Central Government, on matters relating to the conservation of biodiversity, sustainable use of its components and equitable sharing of the benefits arising out of the utilization of biological resources.
- b) To regulate by granting approvals or otherwise requests for commercial utilization or bio survey and bio utilization of any biological resource by Indians.
- c) To perform such other functions as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act or as may be prescribed by the State Government.

**3. As per Rule (22) of the Biodiversity (BD) Rules:**

- i. Every local body shall constitute a Biodiversity Management Committee (BMCs) within its area of jurisdiction.
- ii. The BMC as constituted under sub-rule (1) shall consist of a Chairperson and not more than six persons nominated by the local body, of whom not less than one third should be women and not less than 18 % should belong to the Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribes. They could be an agricultural representative, Collectors/ traders of non-timber forest produces, fishermen, organisations using biodiversity, social workers, teachers and researchers.
- iii. The Chairperson of the Biodiversity Management Committee shall be elected from amongst the members of the committee in a meeting to be chaired by the Chairperson of the local body. The Chairperson of the local body shall have the casting votes in case of a tie.
- iv. The Chairperson of the BMC shall have a tenure of three years.
- v. The local Member of Legislative Assembly/ Member of Legislative Council and Member of Parliament would be special invitees to the meetings of the Committee.
- vi. The main function of the BMC is to prepare People's Biodiversity Register in consultation with local people. The Register shall contain comprehensive information on availability and knowledge of local biological resources, their medicinal or any other use or any other traditional knowledge associated with them.
- vii. The other functions of the BMC are to advice on any matter referred to it by the State Biodiversity Board or Authority for granting approval, to maintain data about the local vairs and practitioners using the biological resources.
- viii. The members should be those residing in the Panchayat area and should be included in the voters list of the Panchayat.
- ix. Panchayat members cannot be members of the BMC.



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- x. Officials of the Forest, Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Health, Fisheries, Education department and research institutions will be special invitees on these committees. The local MLA and MP will be invitees to the meetings of the BMCs.

#### 4. **Scope of work**

4.1 Constitution of Biodiversity Management Committees (BMC) under the local bodies (Gram Panchayat/ Village Council/ Block level) for the purpose of promoting conservation, sustainable use and documentation of biological diversity including preservation of habitats, conservation of land races, folk varieties and cultivars, domesticated stocks and breeds of animals and microorganisms and knowledge relating to biological diversity. (Details enclosed at Annexure I). A sample BMC format duly filled is enclosed at (Annexure II)

#### 4.2 Process of Constitution of BMC:

- Fixing of date of meeting of BMCs in consultation with BDO concerned
- Arrangements for meetings like distribution of publicity material, writing pad, pen and tea/ snacks for meeting (about 40-50 members).
- Presentation before the Gram Panchayat/ Village Council (Gram Sabha) on the role of BMC
- Discussion/ question & answer about BD Act/ BMC etc.
- Signature on Resolution along with attendance sheet.
- Recording of proceedings of meeting.
- Photographic evidence of meeting conducted in the village along with photographs of committee members/Chairman.
- Handing over of Booklets, Registers, Cashbook, Receipt etc. from SBB to the respective BMCs.
- Submission of completed forms & documents to TBB.

#### 5. **SUBMISSION OF PROPOSAL**

- i. The proposal shall be submitted in two parts, viz. Technical and Financial.
- ii. The 'Technical' & 'Financial' proposal must be submitted in two separate sealed envelopes [with respective marking in bold letters].
- (a) The envelop marked TBB "**TECHNICAL PROPOSAL**" for the district North/ Unakoti/ Dhalai/ Khowai/ West Tripura/ Sepahijala/ Gomati/ South Tripura" should include the description of the agency/ organizations etc. its general experience in the field of assignment in other states vis- a- vis success ratio, the qualification and competency of the personnel proposed for the assignment and the proposed methodology, work plan and questionnaire in response to suggested terms of reference. This envelop should not contain any cost information whatsoever.
- (b) The sealed envelope marked TBB "**FINANCIAL PROPOSAL**" for the district North/ Unakoti/ Dhalai/ Khowai/ West Tripura/ Sepahijala/ Gomati/ South Tripura" should contain the detailed cost estimation including taxes as applicable for the proposed task. Financial Proposal of only Technical qualified Agencies/ NGO/ Team will be opened.
- iii. Sealed envelope of Technical & Financial proposal should be placed in one bigger envelop and marked accordingly.
- iv. Erasing/ overwriting in the submitted documents will be **summarily rejected**.
- v. The task of BMC formation in the District should be completed within 3 (three) month from the date of issue of the work order.
- vi. A D-call/ draft of Rs 20,000/- should be deposited as security money payable to DDO (TBB) at Agartala

#### 6. **TECHNICAL CRITERIA**

6.1 Technical proposal for each district should be submitted separately.

- 6.2 Atleast two persons-one of them atleast Graduate another intermediate pass should be engaged for constitution of each BMC. Their bio-data should be enclosed.
- 6.3 The Agency should have at least two years experience working on
- Biodiversity related issues in India. (Necessary documents to be submitted) or
  - Publication of training cum awareness raising material on Biological Diversity. (Necessary documents to be submitted) or
  - Implementation aspects of the biological diversity act at / scheme/ project at state level. (Necessary documents to be submitted)
  - Working with local bodies.
- 6.4 The Agency/ NGO/ Team should have taken up atleast two assignments of Rs 5 lakh each in the past five years.
- 6.5 The Agency/ NGO/ Team should have appropriate registration under Society Registration Act/ Companies Act/ MSME

## **7. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS**

- Rate should be quoted separately for formation of one village level BMC/ Block level BMC for each district separately. Actual number of BMCs will be allotted as per the availability of funds.
- The successful Agency will have to deposit a D-call certificate/ draft for Rs 30,000/- in favour of DDO (TBB) at Agartala as performance guarantee.
- The payment will be made after the completion of constitution of at least 05 BMC. Fund will be released on receipt of the UCs, copy of bank Account Details of the BMCs, 10-15 good resolution photographs of BMC meetings and attendance sheet etc. as given under scope of works & process of constitution of BMC.


## **8. OTHER CONDITIONS**

- The Undersigned reserves the right (i) to modify, expand, restrict, scrap, refloat or cancel in whole/part, the process at any stage without assigning any reasons. (ii) to accept or reject any tender including the lowest one without assigning any reason what so ever. (iii) for accepting the whole or any part of the tender and decision in the matter shall be final and binding.
- After award of the contract, any minor changes in the modus of implementation should be agreed to mutually in writing.
- The rates quoted should be valid for a period of twelve months from the date of acceptance of the rates.
- The submission of tender will bind the Agency to acceptance of all conditions specified herein and in addition to the conditions of the contract.
- The work will be allotted as per the availability of funds.
- An agreement will have to be signed by successful bidder.

## Criteria for selection and Evaluation of the tender

### I. Compulsory Condition:

- Agency/ NGO should be a registered/ legal reputed Agency/ NGO/ Team/ Company.
- Agency/ NGO should have Office and permanent contact address.
- Agency/ NGO should have at least 2 years relevant experience as specified in para 6.
- The Agency should have taken up atleast two assignment of Rs 5 lakh each in the past.

### II. Technical Criteria

- Technical Proposal : 50 Marks;
  - Organizational profile (including self attested photocopy of authorized registration certificate of the organization/ institute): 10 Marks;
  - List of resource persons/ qualification and competency of the personnel proposed for the assignment for each district separately. Then CV should be enclosed: 20 Marks;
  - Tentative work plan, Timeline for organizing the Capacity Building Programme & BMC formation: 10 Marks;
  - Availability of adequate infrastructure and support system to carry out the assignment: 10 Marks
- Relevant Experience with necessary proof: 20 Marks;
  - Experience in the field of assignment in other states for working at block level/ village level.
  - Experience of working on biodiversity / socio economic issues at District/ Block/ Village level in Tripura
  - Experience of working with local bodies

### III. Evaluation Criteria for the Technical bid:

- The award of the contract shall be made district wise to the Agency/ NGO whose offer has been evaluated and determined as:
  - a. Having received the 70% score out of a pre-determined set of technical criteria i.e 49 marks. If three agencies are not eligible, the criteria may be relaxed to 42 marks (i.e 60% of technical points)

### IV. Financial Criteria

- a. Only Agencies obtaining prescribed minimum criteria will be considered for the Financial Evaluation.
- b. Selection will be made by Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) process having Technical/ Financial score weightage to be 60:40.
